

# Graduation Info

**Graduation** is June 16<sup>th</sup> at 11am. You must be in the GMTCC CEC room no later than 9:30 am. Yes, you should bring your cap and gown. Do not iron it, but take it out of the bag and hang it up to remove wrinkles.

**Caps and gowns** will be distributed on May 23rd during lunches in the lobby. Checks for \$22 can be made out to Balfour, or bring cash.

**MANDATORY MARCHING PRACTICE** will be June 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> starting at 1pm and lasting until we get it right, usually two hours on the first day. Please plan ahead. Students will be marching in two rows, alphabetically by last name. If you do not show up for practice, you will not participate in graduation.

**Scholarship forms** will be available the week of April 9th. If you do not return the form by Tuesday, May 1, you will not be eligible for the scholarships.

Your **school email** address will cease to exist on July 1. Please plan accordingly.

The **Senior Checkout Form** will be available on June 4<sup>th</sup> in the guidance office. All of your overdue books (textbooks, library, etc.), tech equipment, etc., must be returned or paid for or you will not receive a diploma. The form is due to Mrs. Cooney no later than Thursday, June 14.

**Tickets for graduation** can be obtained from Ms. St. Cyr in the front office starting June 4th when she signs your Senior Checkout Form. Each student will receive 7 tickets in case graduation must be held indoors. Weather permitting, graduation will be outside and no tickets will be necessary.

**Awards night** is June 14<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm, students must arrive no later than 5:30 pm. Caps and gowns must be worn. Practice for awards night is immediately after marching practice on the 14<sup>th</sup>.
